Electronic Prescribing [Relevant certification criteria: §§170.314.b.3]	This functionality allows providers to send unlimited prescriptions electronically to pharmacies and receive unlimited refill requests from pharmacies. Our Electronic Prescribing offering supports related Meaningful Use and ONC requirements for sending electronic prescriptions.	Providers may pay an annual or monthly subscription fee ongoing based on their preference.	<i>No contractual limitations</i>	<i>No technical or practical limitations</i>
Electronic Results [Relevant certification criteria: §§ 170.314.b.5]	This functionality allows providers to receive unlimited electronic results that are routed through the Delaware Health Information Network. Our Electronic Results offering supports related Meaningful Use and ONC requirements for receiving electronic results	Providers may pay a monthly ongoing fee.	<i>No contractual limitations</i>	<i>No technical or practical limitations</i>
Reporting to Immunization Registries [Relevant certification criteria: §§ 170.314.f.2]	This functionality allows providers to send immunizations electronically to state immunization registries. Our Reporting to Immunization Registries offering supports related Meaningful Use and ONC requirements for submitting immunizations to immunization registries	Providers may pay a monthly ongoing fee.	<i>No contractual limitations</i>	<i>No technical or practical limitations</i>
Receiving/Transmitting Transition of Care Summaries [Relevant certification criteria: §§ 170.314(b)(1) and (2)]	This functionality allows users to send and receive Direct-based messages to/from other users of certified health IT systems. Direct messages may include clinical data, notes, and other information, subject to the limitations noted. Our Direct offerings support related Meaningful Use and ONC requirements for sending and receiving transitions of care summary documents.	Providers may pay a monthly fee ongoing for Direct messaging service.	<i>Users will be limited to exchange Direct Messages with users and 3rd party HISPs that have a trust agreement with Surescripts, the nations largest ePrescribing.</i>	<i>No technical or practical limitations</i>
